

Preparation of abstracts for the 15th International Stellarator Workshop 2005 to be held in Madrid

Here are the instructions for preparing your Stellarator Workshop abstract. All abstracts should be written in English using the formatting instructions outlined below (American or English spelling is acceptable). The abstract should be prepared as formatted single-spaced text for 210 mm by 297 mm (A4) paper. Please use Times or Times New Roman font. Also, please leave 3 cm margins above and below as well as 2.5 cm margins on both sides. The material of the abstract (title, authors, affiliations, figures, footnotes, references, etc.) must fit on one page (within the margins/space on this template). There is no limit to the number of words as long as the abstract does not exceed one page.

The title must be 14 pt in **Bold** centred on the page. Use 12 pt font for the remaining text. On the lines following the title type the names of the authors (initials followed by full last name) and their institutions (*in italic*) followed by a blank line. It is assumed that the first author in the list will be the presenter/contact author. Please indicate if otherwise.

Next, type the abstract justified on both sides. Within the space allotted, authors may use diagrams, equations, and other relevant material for which the lettering is at least as large as the typed text. References should be included using a standard format in 10 pt font at the end of the abstract.¹

The preferred methods for submittal of abstracts are Microsoft Word and/or Adobe PDF. Name your file with the presenter's/author's last name followed by initials and *SW*, for example *McCarthyKJ_SW.doc* or *McCarthyKJ_SW.pdf*. If you are going to present more than one abstract, please add appropriate number(s) after the filename initials [*e.g.* *McCarthyKJ2_SW.doc*]. Abstracts submitted in the body of e-mails, or mailed as hard copies, cannot be accepted.

Please send the finished abstract as either a Word or Adobe pdf file to sw2005@ciemat.es and indicate in the text of the e-mail the preferred form of presentation *i.e.*, oral or poster. Also, include the name, telephone and e-mail address of the contact author in the text of the mail. Finally, include “Stellarator Workshop 2005 Abstract Submission” in the subject header of your mail.
